All disputes, whether by arbitration or otherwise, shall be set, heard, and decided in Carroll County, Ohio.

The buyer is responsible for examining the horses carefully before they bid. Each seller is responsible for guarantees they make on their animals and guarantees will be made only from the auction block while the animal is being sold. Absolutely no guarantee or warranty will be expressed or implied by the auctioneers or ring men. Effort has been made to ensure correctness of the information provided; however, CYA Exchange, LLC, its members, employees, and auctioneers will not assume responsibility for errors or omissions.

Announcements in the ring take precedence over printed information. Any guarantee is between buyer and seller and does not include any other persons or CYA Exchange, LLC. All sales are final.

Buyers: do your homework and inspect the horses extensively. Ask questions about disposition, manners, attitudes, faults, riding ability, comparisons, etc. Use the time before the sale to inspect horses prior to purchasing. Once you bid on a horse, you are implying that you have done your research and no one else is responsible for your decision to purchase. The consignor of each animal represents and warrants to the buyer and to CYA Exchange, LLC. to include but not limited to the following: title of the animal, free from all claims of ownership; if called sound in the ring to be sound of limb, wind and eyes; not a cribber or wind sucker. If said horse is not what the consignor represents it to be, CYA Exchange, LLC management will be the sole decider. Consignor may be expected to take the horse back and give a refund in the amount of the buyer's purchase (money minus commission and fees).

Liability: Buyers, sellers, and spectators are cautioned to exercise care while attending the sale and enter premises at their own risk according to the laws of the State of Ohio. Neither the owners nor any other persons connected with this sale assume any liability, legal or otherwise, for accidents to persons or property, before, during, or after the sale. CYA Exchange, LLC, its principals, directors, officers, agents, employees and volunteers, and landowner, municipal and/or government agency upon whose property this activity is conducted, shall not be liable for injuries sustained by anyone attending the sale. CYA Exchange, LLC, and its associates act as agents only and are not responsible for buyer/seller error or misunderstanding. All guarantees are strictly between the buyer and seller. In further consideration of purchasing at this sale, buyer agrees to indemnify and defend CYA Exchange, LLC, their agents, and associates, from all injury, loss of equipment, loss of animal or damages to self, newly purchased animals or damages or injury to others from animals, by purchasing a horse at CYA Exchange, LLC.
